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JOB SUMMARY:

Under the general supervision of a Program Administrator/Supervisor, perform a variety of skilled maintenance duties to maintain facilities in safe operating condition for students, staff, and the public; maintain a preventive maintenance program; perform skilled maintenance duties related to plumbing, electrical, HVAC systems, fire/security alarms, boilers, and other assigned items to resolve immediate operational and safety concerns.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Install, inspect and repair various items and systems, classroom and office equipment, and facility components related to lighting, roofing, HVAC systems, alarms, plumbing, security, electrical panels, and other items as assigned; perform a variety of skilled maintenance duties to help maintain facilities in a safe, comfortable, and operating condition.
- Inspect facilities, systems, and their components such as playground equipment, HVAC systems, plumbing, and others as assigned; ensure safety and identify necessary repairs to help provide an ongoing program of preventive maintenance.
- Coordinate with Administration and other trades to complete projects and work orders efficiently.
- Repair various items, systems, and components requiring the skills of various maintenance trades including electrical, plumbing, electronics, locksmith, painting, wall board, safety rails, doors, locks, windows, pumps, toilets, and plumbing fixtures; ensure that items, systems, and components are available and in safe working condition.
- Plan, organize and lay out assigned tasks; interpret HVAC plans, diagrams, blueprints, sketches and specifications.
- Assume responsibility for all District security alarm systems and fire alarm systems including installing, servicing, and repairing complete systems and parts.
- Assist with the District's emergency management systems including designing, building, installing, servicing, and repairing complete systems and parts.
- Assist with the District's underground low voltage cable network systems including designing, building, installing servicing, and repairing complete systems and parts.
- Install, service, and repair all electrical and electronic items relating to the district aquatic facilities.
- Safely operate a variety of equipment including hand/power tools and lifts; maintain tools and equipment in safe and operating condition.
- Drive a District vehicle to conduct work.
- Operate a computer and assigned software.
- Prepare documentation and records related to assigned activities including cost estimates, and other assigned items; submit items in the computerized work order system according to established procedures; provide written support and convey information related to assigned activities.
- Submit requests for equipment and supplies; maintain assigned inventory and ensure availability

of required items.

- Respond to emergency situations to resolve immediate safety concerns.
- Transport various items including tools, equipment, and supplies to assist with ensuring the availability of materials required at job site.
- Communicate with personnel and outside agencies as needed to exchange information, coordinate activities, and resolve issues or concerns.
- Attend regular meetings and trainings related to assigned activities.
